Our missionaries took several overnight adventures to **EL CAPULIN**, a fishing community on the northern peninsula of Nicaragua. Along with the community members, we dug over 10,000 feet of trenches and laid pipe for a water system that will bring clean water to over 100 families in this very poor rural area. We hope to begin construction of the concrete tank in September.
