

CODE OF CONDUCT

In order to maintain the integrity of Amigos for Christ and for your protection as a participant in our mission program, the following code of conduct must be followed at all times during the trip. By signing this form, you agree to adhere to the code of conduct presented below:

- All mission trip participants must conduct themselves in a manner which reflects great credit on Amigos for Christ and refrain from behavior that harms the public's perception of the organization. You must accept responsibility for your own decisions and actions.
- Sexual activity of any kind between people that are not married to each other is not allowed.
- Appropriate clothing must be worn at all times at the work site. Short shorts, tops that expose bras (or too much skin) are not permitted by males and females.
- Use of illegal drugs is not allowed.

Additional rules for youth (under 18 years of age):

- Males are to sleep in the "Boys" dorm and females are to sleep in the "Girls" dorm. Minor children are allowed to sleep in the "Family Dorm" room with their family member(s).
- Under no circumstances are the members of one sex permitted overnight in the dorm of the opposite sex.
- Smoking is not allowed by anyone under the age of 18.
- Usage or the purchase of alcohol by anyone under the age of 21 is not permitted.
- Persons under the age of 18 may not leave the Amigos for Christ property (or work sites) unless accompanied by a chaperone/parent and an Amigos for Christ staff member has been notified.
- All participants under the age of 18 are to abide by the curfew set by the chaperones and/or staff as well as
- Please abide by the curfew set by the chaperones and/or staff.

CONSEQUENCES

- Immediate notification of parents/guardians if under 18 years of age.
- Possible early departure at your expense or, if under 18, at your parents' expense.
- Future mission trips with Amigos for Christ may not be permitted. Amigos for Christ reserves the right to decline any mission trip participant applicant.
