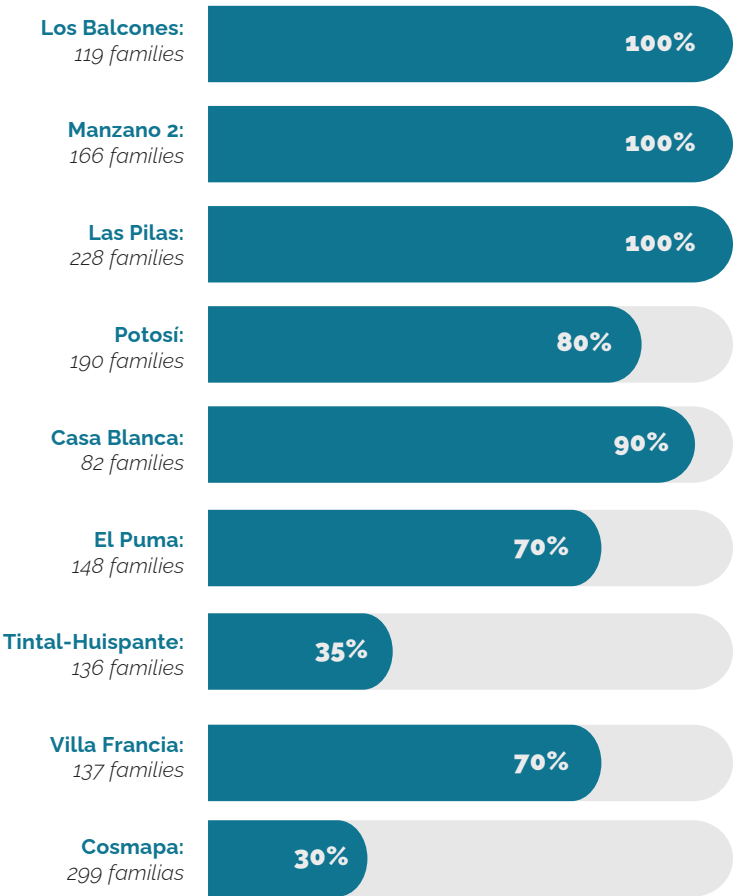
# Transformation Highlights



## WATER FOR CHINANDEGA

166 families in Manzano 2 have 24/7 access to clean water after inaugurating their water system in August. We also broke ground on two new water systems in Villa Francia and El Puma, putting 285 new families on the path to transformation.

Through September 2025, **157 Modern Bathrooms** and **128 Clean Air Kitchens** have been built in 4 rural communities! **Oniel and Carlos are brothers, neighbors, and business partners, born and raised in the community of Valle los Morenos.** Not long ago, these brothers struggled to provide for their families, making modest livings through agriculture.

They were hopeful, however, when they were presented with a Gift of Opportunity: two pregnant pigs and the materials necessary to build a pig pen. From that investment, a thriving business was born. The brothers have generated enough revenue through their pig business not only to provide for their wives and children, but also to reinvest and grow their business. Their next goal is to expand the structure that serves as the pig pen to make room to raise even more pigs. They hope to be able to hire employees soon to help.
